

Level 2 Diploma for the Early Years Practitioner

WHO IS THIS QUALIFICATION FOR:

Level 2 will suit you if you work, or are about to work, in a supporting role as a nursery assistant, Crèche worker or special educational needs assistant. You want to work with children, but you'll generally work under supervision.

These bespoke qualifications will provide the fundamental skills needed to enter or sustain employment in this area, instilling learners with the confidence and drive to achieve continued personal and professional progression

PROGRESSION ROUTE:

Providing important recognition, these qualifications encourage learners to unleash their talents, through further vocational training or in their field of work, the next natural progression would be the Early Years Practitioner (EYE) Diploma at Level 3. However, if learners do not already hold GCSE Grade A-C in Maths and English or Functional Skills level 2 then they will need to obtain these before progressing onto the level 3 Diploma

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- Working regularly within a setting to a minimum of 10hrs per week
- Hold a current DBS
- At Level 2 - you will need to be in an assistant role, voluntary or employed

ASSESSMENT:

For all competency-based units learners are subject to direct observation in a working environment.

Regular monthly support via telephone/eportfolio or visits to the setting.

Knowledge is assessed via assignments and a portfolio of evidence uploaded via an e-portfolio online. Paper-based is also on offer on request.

Some of the evidential material used in portfolios includes; witness testimonies, professional discussion and the learners' own plans and written records.
