

LEVEL 2 CERTIFICATE AND LEVEL 3 DIPLOMA FOR SUPPORTING TEACHING AND LEARNING IN SCHOOLS

Qualification Aim:

Working within the school environment is as diverse as it is rewarding, with job roles ranging from assistants to learning and development specialist support workers. These bespoke qualifications will provide the fundamental skills needed to enter or sustain employment in this area, instilling learners with the confidence and drive to achieve continued personal and professional progression.

Qualification Levels:

At each level, learners combine compulsory and optional units to achieve individual on-the-job training and support.

Progression Routes:

Providing important recognition, these qualifications encourage learners to unleash their talents, through further vocational training or in their field of work.

ASSESSMENT:

For all competency-based units learners are subject to direct observation in a working environment. Regular monthly visits and contact via telephone and email.

Knowledge is assessed via assignments and a portfolio of evidence,.

Some of the evidential material used in portfolios includes; witness testimonies, professional discussion and the learners' own plans and written records.

TRAINING AND SUPPORT:

Access to a wide range of support and materials such as workbooks for Food Hygiene and Health and Safety plus the access to the XTRAS site and a set text handbook issued to all learners.

Individual needs are met, learning needs are assessed and supported within the setting and through an assessor.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Working within a setting to a minimum of 10hrs per week
- Hold a current DBS
- At Level 2 - need to be in an assistant role, voluntary or employed
- At Level 3 - needs to be in paid employment and show competence at that level
